

Jim Zamzow's Secret Recipe for Compost Tea

Step 1. Using a 5 gallon bucket add 1 part Chicken Soup For The Soil to 9 parts water (1/2 gallon Chicken Soup & 4.5 gallons water).

Step 2. Add your choice of microbes. Use a handful of quality soil or pure earthworm castings.

Step 3. Stir what is in your bucket and place it in a warm room or outside if it is summer. The main thing is to keep it warm.

Step 4. Stir often, at least daily. More frequently is better. Alternatively, add 1 cup of 3% hydrogen peroxide, and you will be good to go.

Fermenting time will vary depending on temperature:

Three days at 80 to 90 degrees. Five days at 70 to 80 degrees. Seven days under 70 degrees

Use all your Chicken Soup Compost Tea™ immediately. Apply directly to the soil under your plants. You can also mix 1 part tea with 10 parts water and apply to the foliage.
